GUIDELINES AT A GLANCE

- Troop/Group fund raising standards are found in the <u>Safety-Wise</u>, standards 28-33.
- It is recommended that troops participate in at least 1 council sponsored fund raiser (i.e. cookies, fall product sale).
- All fund raising must be approved by council.
- In most cases, no more than 2 projects (besides cookies and fall product) per troop, per year are allowed. Special consideration may be given to troops planning Wider Opportunities.
- NO money raising projects are allowed during United Way/Community Chest campaign (September/October) nor during council cookie and fall product sale order taking,
- Girls must be registered members to participate in money raising projects.
- NO Girl Scout Troop/Group will be allowed to raise funds for an organization other than Girl Scouts of Moingona Council, its members, troops, and Service Unit.
- Daisy Girl Scouts are not allowed to raise money.
- All money-earning projects should be an extension of the Girl Scout Program.
